Note A: Israel arrives and camps in Etham at sunset on Abib 18 Ex 13:20; Num 33:6 - Israel turns south and begins 55 to 60 mile forced trek in 2 days to Pi-Hahiroth, Ex 14:1, Num 33:7 - Arrives at Pi-Hahiroth on Abib 20 at sunset, faces Red Sea, Ex 14:2. Waters divided this night, Ex 14:21

Note B: This whole scenario is covered in Ex 14:1-31 as the Egyptian army arrives shortly after Israel camps at Pi-Hahiroth on Abib 20. Waters begin to part around sunset and Israel takes all night to travel the 10 miles across the Red Sea (Gulf of Aqaba) to Baal-zephon then depart for Marah. Egyptian army destroyed morning of Abib 21 when Red Sea closes.

* There are two schools of thought as to the date of the exodus.
 • This chart, based on the early date theory, has the year of the exodus somewhere in the mid-1440s B.C. during the time of the 18th Egyptian dynasty with Amenhotep II as pharaoh.
 • The late date theory has the year of the exodus somewhere around 1270-1260 B.C. during the time of the 19th Egyptian dynasty with Rameses II as pharaoh.
